 - Jana suggested a panel about a non-academic job opportunity.
 - Abigail suggested a penal in collaboration with relevant caucus for discourses about creating spaces for other voices in academia beyond WEIRD.
 - Maddy added that we can collaborate with intercultural division, DEI; it can be panel or discussion board.

- Shuvo suggested a panel that looks at the state of DEI initiative in the US; how we can regulate the discourse considering our current climate.
- Makenzie also suggested a panel to help promote graduate school to non-traditional student and how to bring DEI activities into the classroom as instructors.
